

SELHuG: Nominations now open for officer roles and committee

Dear All,

The AGM is on Thursday 20 July. If you would like to stand for any of the officer roles or be on the committee, please let the Secretary, Libby, know at least seven days before the AGM in writing to selhuginfo@gmail.com.

Please say which role you are applying for and a short summary of what you bring in terms of relevant interests, skills or experience to the role.

Noone has said, yet, that they will stand for the posts of Secretary or Treasurer, so we are particularly looking for members to fill these posts. Thank you to those who have already expressed an interest in standing for the committee.

Brief descriptions of the roles are below, to help you decide if you would like to stand:

Chair

1. Provide leadership to the group and committee, working closely with the committee to provide worthwhile monthly meetings plus social events and public/outreach activities.
2. Introduce meetings and lead discussions
3. Lead the group's public face

Treasurer

1. Hold bank account, paying in subs and other income, and paying out bills – usually once a month
2. Keep record of all monies in and out, and the members' list
3. Prepare simple accounts for the AGM

Secretary

1. Check and respond to the SELHuG email
2. Be the main contact for organising meetings
3. Provide introduction and other content for the newsletter, and update list of newsletter recipients

Committee members

- Provide ideas for meetings, social and public events, and organise or share organisation of some of them
- Contribute to setting the general direction and activities of the group (usually two committee meetings a year plus impromptu discussions)
- Specific tasks if you've got the skills and willingness to take them on. For instance, Sam will continue to manage and update the website and send out the newsletter, and Trevor will continue as social media lead.

And right now we are looking for volunteers from anyone in the group to

- Come early to organise refreshments
- Help with media work including social media
- Also, if you don't want to take on a formal role but have an interest – it might be in education and faith schools, or interfaith initiatives, or assisted dying – talk to us. You could potentially lead a short campaign, or ensure we are better informed on the subject, or be our liaison with HUK.
